Applications must be postmarked by March 9, 2019 to be considered for a 2019 award. Minimum amount awarded for an individual scholarship will be **\$1,000.00**.

Eligibility Criteria – Applicant must be:

- Currently involved in Destination Imagination in a significant manner (i.e. Team Member, Team Manager, Appraiser, Instant Challenge Day Organizer, etc.)
- Be at least a senior in high school or older

### **To be included with your application:**

- 1.) One letter of recommendation from someone who is or has been a part of your involvement with creative problem solving
- 2.) One letter of recommendation from someone of your choosing (optional)
- 3.) A short (no more than one page), personal essay, including, but not limited to:
  - Your personal strengths and interests, and extracurricular activities
  - Your future plans and goals for continuing your education
  - Your involvement with creative problem solving, including current activities
- 4.) A “Creative Picture of You” –

Here is your chance to be creative! We want to know about YOU and how Destination Imagination and creative problem solving have influenced your life. Choose one of the formats below to best convey this “Creative Picture of You” (if you mail in your application, it must fit in a 9” x 12” envelope):

- Audio – original song with lyrics. Mail lyrics and CD of song, or email DOC or PDF of the lyrics and MP3 of the song
- Visual presentation – PowerPoint (in ppt or pptx) or video (in WAVE, MP4, or Quicktime). Mail five printed copies or digital file (loaded on flashdrive, CD, etc.), or email as an attachment in the above formats
- Story – must be typed, double-spaced, and limited to 2-5 pages. Mail a printed copy, or email a DOC or PDF of the story
- Poem – must be typed, double-spaced, and limited to 2-3 pages. Mail a printed copy, or email a DOC or PDF of the story
- Essay – must be typed, double-spaced, and limited to 2-3 pages. Mail a printed copy, or email a DOC or PDF of the story
- Internet content – must be submitted in a form distributable via the Internet (i.e. free of intellectual property infringements and viewable with a standard browser). Mail CD/DVD with complete HTML or other launchable files format or link, or email the URL of the site
- Have another idea? Awesome! Go for it! (The only limitation is that it must fit into a mailing envelope if you are mailing in your application)

### **Weighting:**

Letter(s) of Recommendation – 10%

Extracurricular involvement – 5%

Essay describing strengths, goals, and involvement with DI – 35%

Creative Picture of You – 45%

Completion of application – 5%
